Location:

Paton Park Scout Camp is nestled beneath the Dial Range on Tasmania's picturesque North West Coast. The facility is situated on 140 hectares of beautiful Australian bushland.

Accommodation options:

- Bunk rooms: Share rooms with bunk, mattresses provided (bring your own bedding)
- Tents: Bring your own tent or reserve one (first come, first served)
- Caravans: Bring your own or rent one.

Meals:

- **Breakfast and lunch:** It is the responsibility of individual campers to prepare their own breakfast and lunch. Some basic supplies are available (bread, milk, butter, spreads, cereal). If campers would like anything else, they will need to provide it themselves.
- **Evening meal:** The evening meal is provided by the camp. Camp teams take turns in assisting with meal preparation and clean-up.
- **Tea and Coffee:** Provided by the camp.
- **Water:** The tap water at the campsite is suitable for drinking. However, you can bring your own bottled water if you wish, or it can be purchased from the tuck shop.
- **Tuck Shop:** Cold drinks, ice-creams and lollies are available for purchase at low cost from the tuck shop. You can pay for items with correct change or keep a tab and pay at the end of camp.

Note: There is some fridge space available for personal supplies, but please note that it is limited. Please make sure that all items are clearly marked with your name.

OTHER INFORMATION:

Don't forget to bring:

Bible, hat, warm jacket, wet weather gear, all bedding (sleeping bag, sheet, pillows, air mattress etc), towels, toiletries, breakfast and lunch supplies (beyond the basics), snacks.

There are no laundry facilities at the camp, so bring enough clothes to last the week.

The closest supermarket is in Ulverstone, which is around 15 minutes away.

Transportation:

If flying into Launceston, you may need to arrange your own transportation to and from Devonport, depending on the day and time you arrive. There is a Kinetic Bus Service which travels between the two cities. If flying or sailing into Devonport, contact us if you need to be picked up. Please let us know what you need and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Camp Rules

Behaviour:

Campers are not to participate in smoking, drinking alcohol, drugs, bad language or any other behaviour not becoming of a Christian.

Clothing:

Modest clothing of a high Christian standard should be worn at all times. It is requested that both women and men wear clothing that covers the shoulders, and goes to the knee.

Supervision of children:

Children attending camp must be accompanied by a responsible adult, who agrees to provide adequate supervision at all times. **Children under 12 are not to be in the kitchen without adult supervision.**
